Which types of workshops?

Workshops may cover a wide range of topics within the Climate Camp. The workshops should focus, however, less on academic and theoretical content and more on interactive and practical themes. This year's focus is on *antiracism and antifascism in the context of the climate justice movement*. Discriminatory topics or conspiracy theories are excluded and will not be considered.

The main languages used at the camp will be German and English. Workshops can be offered in other languages, as long as arrangements for interpretation are made in advance.

We would also like to create a special low-threshold programme that brings the socio-ecological transformation of the camp to life for children and young adults who may experience difficulty in accessing them.

As most of the workshops so far were instructed by white Cis-people, we especially welcome applications from women*/BIPoC and LGBTIQ.

We would like to have workshops on the following topics:

Antiracism:

- What is racism? / Critical whiteness / Cultural appropriation
- Climate justice: Global exploitation / Forced
 migration as a consequence of climate change
- Capitalism and racism
- Postcolonialism
- Stories of the resistance movement
- Migration politics / Migration struggles

Antifascism:

- Imperialist way of life / Fortress Europe and externalization
- Right-wing structures in the climate movement
- Ecology/degrowth and the new fascist movement
- Right-wing resistance against the climate movement
- Regional elections 2019 (in Saxony): What would a government participation of the AfD mean for the future?

Social-ecological transformation:

- Utopias / Thinking about the future
- Climate justice
